Ramadhan Programme

- Fajr Prayer will be 15 minutes after entry time.
- I'shaa and Taraweeh prayers will start at the times in the table on the right.
- There will be a short reminder every Saturday 30 minutes before collective iftar.
- Women and children aged 11 plus are most welcome to attend Taraweeh, Jum'ah and Eid prayers
- Children under the age of 11 should be supervised by their parents/carers all the time.
- ZAKATUL-FITR: a minimum of £3.50 per person is recommended. It is preferable if this is paid early, so that it reaches the needy by Eid.
